APM01/14 Welcome

Cllr Dickin welcomed everyone to the meeting including Chris Price and Trevor Lafferty.

APM02/14 Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on the 14 March 2013 to be approved and signed.

APM03/14 Annual Report of the Parish Council

Cllr Dickin gave a report on the Council's activities during the year. He highlighted the Parish Meeting regarding Wind Turbines in the Parish, working with the Millennium Hall and Ellesmere Medical Practice to complete the smooth closure of the Doctor's Surgery in Cockshutt and progress of Shropshire Council's Planning Policy known as SAMDev. Expenditure of the Council included the new street light opposite the school and a new LED light by the shop. Additional grit bins had also been purchased.

APM04/14 Jubilee Field Development

Cllr Cooling as Chair of the Advisory Committee introduced Chris Price, private consultant and Trevor Lafferty from Leightmain. Chris Price presented the Committee's preferred plan of the Field and Trevor Lafferty presented options for a MUGA. Questions were invited from residents. It was agreed that the proposal met with the wishes of the community.

APM05/14 Highway Safety in Cockshutt

Cllr Dickin explained that Highways was a standing item on Parish Council's meetings agenda. He highlighted the key areas of concern: the roundabout at the Meadows, speeding and parking at the School. General discussion took place and it was agreed that the following should be explored by the Parish Council and the community: 20 mph signs at the School, upgrade of street lights, pelican crossing, dropping off area for School parents and cutting back of hedges to allow better vision when leaving the Millennium Hall.

APM06/14 Parish Debate

Comments were made about: the length of grass at the back of the Churchyard, flooding on the pavement outside the Parish Hall, grate by the Donkey Field being full of mud and the camber of the road resulting with residents being splashed by passing traffic when raining.

The Chair, Cllr John Dickin, declared the meeting closed at 9pm.
