APM01/15 Welcome

Cllr Dickin welcomed everyone to the meeting.

APM02/15 Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on the 19 May 2014 to be approved and signed.

APM03/15 Annual Report of the Parish Council

Cllr Dickin gave a report on the Council's activities during the year. He highlighted the slow progress of Shropshire Council's Planning Policy known as SAMDev which will not know be adopted this Spring. The School was 'ticking over' and it was hoped that a new owner of the Shop would soon be in place. It was understood that the Leaking Tap's change of ownership was progressing. Discussions at Council meetings during the year included planning applications and road safety. Cllr Dickin thanked both the Clerk and Vice Chair for their contribution to the smooth running of the Council.

APM04/15 Jubilee Field Development

Cllr Cooling reviewed progress of the project and advised Planning Permission had been granted for the preferred development. A condition regarding surface drainage would have to be satisfied. It was planned that quotes and research into funding would be progressed this year. Questions were raised regarding timing. Cllr Cooling expected work to commence Spring 2016.

APM05/15 Highway Safety along Shrewsbury Road, Cockshutt

Cllr Dickin explained that Highways was a standing item on Parish Council's meeting agenda. General discussion took place. It was agreed that some traffic calming measures would be reliant on payment of Community Infrastructure Levy. Comments were also made about the standard of the roundabout at The Meadows and the tractors and trucks visiting the Potato Store.

APM06/15 Parish Debate

General discussion took place on lack of Broadband in Petton, dog fouling on the Playing Field (and football pitch) and the planning application On Land to The West of Shrewsbury Road, Cockshutt
