43/17 Mouchel Report A528 Cockshutt Speed Management March 2017

Following lengthy discussion, it was resolved to support options 1, 2 and 3 (mini roundabout improvements, 0.75m buildouts with informal crossing (by school) and advisory part-time 20mph speed limit (centre)). Option 4 (40mph buffer zone (southern end) was noted but the installation of a Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) was considered to potentially have more impact in this area. It was agreed that a VAS at both ends of the village and double yellow lines within the 30mph area should also be considered by Shropshire Council. It was agreed to seek clarification from Shropshire Council regarding the availability of the funding required for the scheme and implementation timescales.
