APM01/18 Welcome

Cllr Cooling welcomed everyone to the meeting.

APM02/18 Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on the 13 April 2017

The minutes of the meeting held on 13th April 2017 were approved and signed by the chairman Cllr. Cooling

APM03/18 Annual Report of the Parish Council

Cllr Cooling presented his report and included comments on:

- a. Appeal for parish councillors
- b. Community Led Plan questionnaires are nearly ready and will be sent out in May. They can be done online or by post, returns to Rural Community Council and will include a prize draw
- c. Traffic calming, the feedback is positive for vehicle activated signs in centre and north of village but due to Shropshire Council 5m cut back this year and next year, priorities mean it's unlikely that the work will be done in near future.
- d. Planning: there are 5 allocated SAMdev sites, building has commenced on one at Chapel House farm with one approved on Parklands: two applications have been withdrawn.
- e. Jubilee Field project is not progressing as fast as we would like. Obtaining quotes for the ground work is ongoing; the quote for the MUGA is accepted. The Parish Council need all quotes before applying for funding but is hopeful that this will be this year.

APM04/18 Parish Debate

General discussion took place on:

- a. A resident of one year standing raised 3 matters:
 - Elderly with no computers may have reservations on filling in questionnaire information
 - Traffic calming; concerns regarding speeding on main road at northern end of village past the roundabout & suggested a speed camera and mobile unit
 - Anticipated noise issues for residents close to jubilee field/hall

The Parish will try safer roads partnership & speed watch again; this has not happened in the past due to lack of volunteers

- b. Is the CLP questionnaire aimed at businesses as well?

- c. The Meadows development is completed but the roads are not yet adopted by Shropshire Council; Cllr. Cooling gave an update on situation.
- d. Update re the mobile telephone mast in Petton; apparently there is difficulty with getting power to the site.
- e. Is the Parish Council doing anything to save the Leaking Tap by making it a community asset? Cllr. Cooling explained that it would not be feasible for the Parish Council to do this without resources.
- f. There may be difficulty with Cockshutt as a hub as we are now losing the shop and shortly the post office and pub.
- g. Suggestion to the Hall to have barrier to prevent people coming onto the car park when there are no meetings to prevent anti-social behaviour on field and car park.

The Chair, Cllr John Cooling, declared the meeting closed at 7.50 pm.
