**86/20 Highways**

a. Updates

There is a flooding issue along the side road to Kenwick Springs near Spring Cottages. Clerk will report to highways.

The street lighting issues on the Meadows has been reported, it appears that the Meadows lighting is not registered on Shropshire Council maintenance system yet although the road was adopted in February this year.

b. A528 Traffic Calming

In 2017 Shropshire Council commissioned a report on Speed Management on the A528. The report noted that the stepped speed limit at the south end of Cockshutt village was the preferred option for traffic calming. At the northern end the roundabout has some effect of slowing vehicles. Following Shropshire Council's recent report on the "School Streets" Initiative the Parish Council resolved to

- collect data from Speedwatch group to establish whether the speeding issues are still at the southern end or whether there are now issues at the northern end of the village
- contact Shropshire Council to request that the installation of 20mph advisory in Cockshutt be expedited.
