85/21 Jubilee Field

Trees for Shropshire project has visited Jubilee Field; if the parish wishes to be involved the project will provide a plan and plant native trees at no cost. Restoring Shropshire's Verges Project recommended leaving an area of the Jubilee Field uncut for one season to assess the wildflower spread.
