Members considered the current entries in the Place Plan and noted:-

Priority A:

• Flood risk management infrastructure managed by Shropshire Council and Environment Agency. The localised flooding in Park Road appears to have been resolved. There is some flooding at times at English Frankton which appears to be a maintenance issue when grips are not maintained and become overwhelmed.

Neighbourhood Projects:

- Additional and improved street lighting in Cockshutt to remain on the list, this is ongoing as the Parish Council replace failed sodium lights with LED. A previous review of electricity accounts did not show any benefit from change of supplier, however an updated review may inform the future purchase of electricity.
- Footpaths to remain, improvement and maintenance is ongoing via P3 group.
- Jubilee Field project to remain subject to future review
- Highways, the VAS has now been installed at the northern end of the village. Community Speed watch is ongoing. Item to remain in the Place Plan until the results of the survey of 20 mph advisory outside the school is known.
- Adoption of street lighting at The Meadows is complete, remove.
- 30 mph speed limit at Willowbrook Manor is ongoing. Retain item currently.
- Members to consider any additional projects for inclusion

## d. Petton Defibrillator

Has been ordered and paid for, delivery is expected in the next day or two. A local training provider is offering free training, clerk to contact other groups managing defibrillators in the Parish to enquire whether they would be interested in taking up the offer of training.

e. Village Hall Security Camera

Village Hall Committee has assured the PC in relation to the new camera that:

- the camera has settings that can cut out parts of the view, so will ensure the camera just looks just at the drive and avoids neighbouring gardens, and
- will turn the flashing lights off so they do not cause annoyance to the neighbouring property
- Clerk advised whoever manages the data must be registered with ICO and has been in touch with the Village Hall Committee to that effect.
