#### 111/23 Jubilee Field & Football Field

#### a. Playing field

Members attended a meeting with the Village Hall and Football Club regarding the adequacy of grass cutting on the football field. The grass was cut yesterday although there is still a large amount of detritus on the pitch. Cllr. Bowers has arranged for clippings to be removed tomorrow.

Football Club to supply a programme of matches to the Parish Council. Clerk to speak with the contractor to see if it is possible either to remove the clippings after mowing or if they can schedule weekly cuts during October.

# b. Jubilee field

CPRE are looking for hedging sites, however the Jubilee Field hedging is complete and we do not require more plants. There are no other identified sites in the vicinity.

Cllr. Harrison responded to the questionnaire following the supply and planting from Shropshire Council subsidised tree scheme.

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### 112/23 Highways

Requests under SC Road Safety Policy -

a. A528 request from WLPC for support regarding adequacy of road markings (email 22/8/23) Shropshire Cllr. Williams updated the Parish Council on this matter. WLPC would like to see unbroken white lining along the length of the A528 from Ellesmere to Shrewsbury. The highway authority (LHA) is carrying out a complete assessment which will be circulated to all Parish Councils on the route once completed.

Members agreed to respond accepting support for the request to Shropshire Council for a review of road markings on the A528 and acknowledging that this is already in progress.

# 113/23 Reports of Meetings Attended:

The Chairman attended a surgery held by Helen Morgan MP in Cockshutt. The main topic of discussion was road safety on the A528. The Chairman made the meeting aware of the 2017 Mouchel report and Shropshire Council proposals with regard to 20 mph zones outside schools.
