50/26 Apologies for absence:

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr. P. Brewer

51/26 Election of Chair for the coming year and declaration of acceptance of office

Cllr. P. Griffiths was proposed and seconded. There being no other nominations Cllr. Griffiths was elected unanimously as Chair for coming year and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office

52/26 Election of Vice Chair for the coming year – deferred

53/26 Public Participation:

A resident and former member of CMH Committee attended and updated members following the Hall's AGM. Members of the existing VH Committee stood down. Three former VH committee members agreed to stand as an interim committee and run the Hall for a period of not more than 12 months including a review of how the Hall is managed. They anticipated that the Hall will break even on income/general expenditure however any major repairs will deplete reserves so they may be looking to the Parish Council for financial support in the coming 12 months. The Chair assured the meeting that the Parish Council will endeavour to help in any way it can.

Chair informed the Meeting that works will be commencing on the Jubilee Field car park on Monday, 29th June. A resident suggested as part of the project that the existing car park should be white lined to control parking.

A resident enquired regarding the need for traffic calming on A528.

A resident enquired regarding responsibility for cutting hedges adjacent to the footpaths on Shrewsbury Road from Kenwick Close to the Hall. The hedges on private land are the responsibility of the landowner.

Cllr. Marston updated the meeting:

a. Traffic Calming A528

Work has begun with regard to the 20 mph school zone on the A528, the option of a pelican crossing is being considered subject to highway safety analysis at the design stage. The design phase is planned for 2026 with build stage anticipated in 2027/28. The Parish Council has indicated if necessary a financial contribution to the installation of a crossing.

- b. Replacement Speed Signs
The Local Highway Authority has no objection to replacement signs subject to approval of the design and size. The solar powered sign at the south end of the village can be replaced at the Parish Council's discretion subject to highway approval and installation on the existing pole.

The sign at the north end of the village, because it is connected to the grid, must be from a Shropshire Council approved supplier. As this sign might also be impacted by the design and installation of the 20 mph school speed zone it would be better to wait until after the design stage of the A528 traffic calming project.
